New snow avalanches on Saddle Peak

A snowboarder triggered a shallow avalanche (estimated 4-6 inches deep) on Saddle Peak in the new snow. The <u>slide</u> was as the snowboarder dropped off "Quarter Saddle" and a second pocket propagated above him as he traversed out of the first <u>slide</u>.

Another <u>slide</u> was seen from the highway in Argentina Bowl. This <u>slide</u> appears to be a shallow soft <u>slab</u> that \sim 50 ft wide and ran \sim 500 vertical ft.

From IG: Some people got something to run long off the south peak. People were center punching Argentina and north saddle without consequence, but the wind slabs were generally dense enough to propagate but not so dense that they weren't easy to trigger.
