We rode over Lulu Pass and around Fisher Peak into Abundance drainage. There was 8" of new snow that fell since Saturday, up to 12" north of Daisy. Wind was light to moderate and could see snow transport at peaks and ridgelines. Snowed most of the day with some heavy pulses, and some periods of decent visibility.

Light was flat, but didn't see any [slab](#) avalanches today while riding. I just spotted one small [slab](#) from town with binos on the east face of Mineral. There were a couple very small loose slides off the highest ridge of Henderson.
